



NPC continues to campaign for changes to improve road safety in Newbald. Of particular concern are Burgate, The Green, Ratten Row, Galegate, Westgate and South Newbald Road. We know that vehicles do use the village as a short cut from the A1034 to High Hunsley junction on the B1230 (and vice versa). Many of them speed despite blind corners, parked cars, and sharp bends. We fear that this is an accident waiting to happen.

Members of Newbald Parish Council recently met with a Senior Engineer from East Riding of Yorkshire Council in the village to discuss what measures could be taken.

Unfortunately, while the ERYC Officer we met was very helpful, her hands are tied. ERYC continues to take the position that, as there have not been any serious accidents in Newbald, the area is low risk and therefore no funding will be made available for traffic calming measures.

NPC has heard this so many times. For many years now, road safety has remained high on our priority list. We have appealed to ERYC in different ways for help and we always get knocked back. So, what can we do? If implementing road traffic calming measures in Newbald is important to you, please write to ERYC and Graham Stuart MP to let them know how strongly you feel about it. The contact details are available on our website. Maybe if ERYC hears from many others and not just the Parish Council, it may decide to take some action. We really do not want to experience a motorist or pedestrian being hurt because of the road traffic problems we are experiencing.
